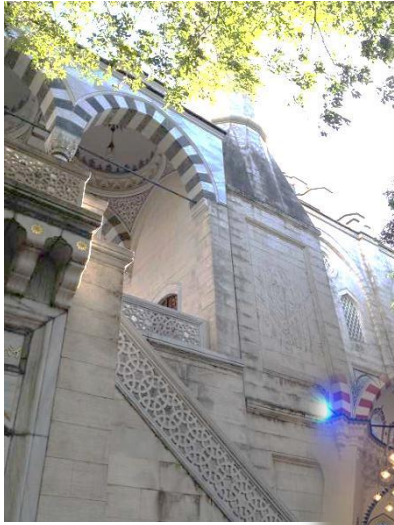


SOMOS International School
